TOPICS, FORMAT AND CRITERIA FOR CONFERENCE SUBMISSIONS

The theme of the conference is **Sweden's engineering programmes – meeting the challenges of today and the future**. For instance, this may include a submission on:

Types of education, for example:

- Lifelong learning and flexible learning
- Broad participation – flexible learning activities and learning environments
- Digitalisation – hybrid instruction and flexible participation
- Interdisciplinary viewpoints
- Value creation through collaboration and global perspectives
- Learning mode of assessments

Challenges, for example:

- Education in sustainability
- Societal challenges and application in education
- Learning for a digitalised working life

Focus on students, for example:

- Students' learning and skills for the future
- Active student participation
- The student as co-producer of research

The submissions may have the following formats: presentations, work in progress, workshops or roundtable discussions. Information for each type of submission (criteria, length of abstract, etc.) is available on the website.

Submissions will be accepted in Swedish or English. The language of the presentation should be consistent with the written language of the abstract submission and title.
